## **Dress Code Policy**

Freire Charter School Wilmington expects that all students will dress like college scholars while valuing the opportunity for individual expression. Student attire should respect the school's intent to sustain a safe environment and a community that is inclusive of a diverse range of identities. Student attire should not interfere with the health or safety of any student nor contribute to a hostile or intimidating atmosphere for any student. Students are expected to follow the dress code policy at all times while on school grounds and on school-sponsored trips. Courses at times may require attire or specified dress necessary for an assignment or activity (e.g. closed-toe shoes for a lab experiment, professional dress for a presentation). Students who do not adhere to these expectations will be written up and will receive a consequence. A student may be asked to change into alternative clothing in order to adhere to the policy.
