- **III. Review of Finances –** Bill Ray, Controller of Build the Future, presented the financials for the month ending November 30, 2015. As the financials were reviewed, the committee discussed a series of items as follows:
 - Bill Ray noted that updates will be made to the next version of the budget to more closely align with actual expenditures to date.
 - Financial summary, balance sheet, P&L, cash flow, budget and website documents were reviewed.
 - Requirements for fund raising were reviewed across several scenarios. Committee
 confirmed that there is a plan for cash flow in the event that fund raising falls short of
 goals.
 - List of expenditure payees was reviewed, along with process flow for submission and approval of expenditures.
 - Reviewed projected charter performance framework (financial) across 3 scenarios based on fund raising results.
