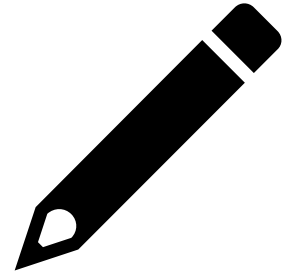




Everything You Need to Know About Title I
